



The further qualification of professional drivers in the field of trucks and buses is an important element to improve safety on the roads, but also factors such as the reduction of CO2 emissions are positively influenced by the Eco drive training. An essential success factor to ensure the knowledge transfer of the C95 training is to motivate the participants to take part in the training. This requires didactically trained trainers who know how to make training days interesting, but also how to solve problems such as different language levels of the participants or intercultural conflicts among the participants. Another important factor is that C95 trainers have competences in integrating ICT tools into face-to-face trainings or in designing long distance learning materials. Thus, a professional C95 trainer needs not only technical know-how such as vehicle technology, eco-drive, load securing, digital tachograph, etc., but also extensive knowledge of didactics and pedagogy in adult education. Exactly these latter skills are the focus of our Erasmus+ Project Proc95trainer.

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
